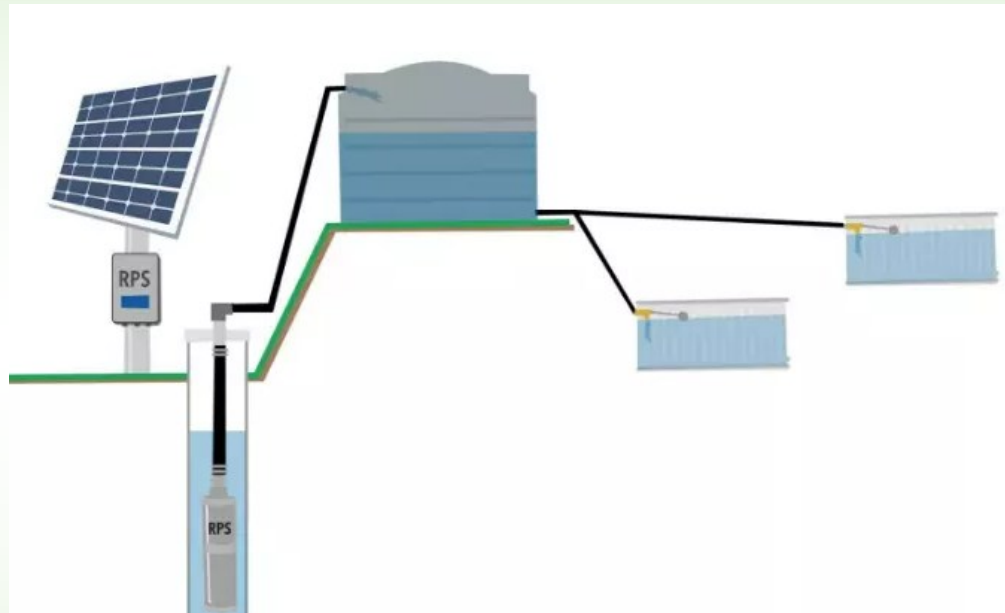
Cost Share on Agriculture Practices

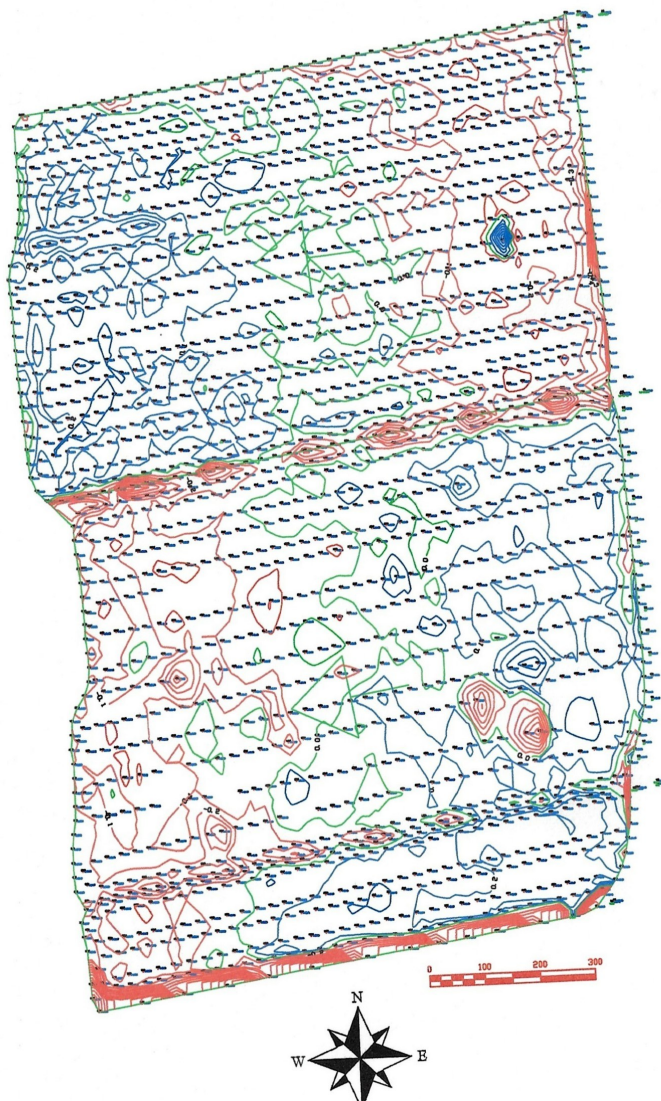
Do you have a livestock well that you're currently burning a lot of diesel or racking up huge electric bills to keep running?
